**AMENDMENTS TO
THE BYLAWS OF
SOMERSET BAY CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.
AND THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
SOMERSET BAY CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.**

The Declaration of Condominium of Somerset Bay, a Condominium, is recorded in Official Records Book 1408, at Page 0244, of the Public Records of Indian River County, Florida. The Bylaws of Somerset Bay Condominium Association, Inc. were recorded in Official Records Book 1408, at Page 0311, of the Public Records of Indian River County, Florida. The Articles of Incorporation of Somerset Bay Condominium Association, Inc. were recorded in Official Records Book 1408, at Page 0302, of the Public Records of Indian River County, Florida.

As indicated herein, words underlined are added and words ~~struck through~~ are deleted.

Item 1: Article 4, Section A of the Bylaws of Somerset Bay Condominium Association, Inc. ("Bylaws"), shall be amended follows:

4. BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION AND OFFICERS

A. The Board of Administration shall consist of ~~a minimum of three (3) directors with the number determined by a vote of majority of a quorum of members at a membership meeting. Each director elected at the first annual meeting of the membership thereafter shall serve for term of one (1) year or until his successor is duly elected.~~ five (5) Directors. Commencing with the Annual Meeting and Election of Directors in 2010, Directors shall be elected for staggered terms as follows: the three (3) candidates who receive the highest plurality of the votes shall be elected for a term of two (2) years. The two (2) candidates with the next highest plurality of the votes shall be elected for a term of one (1) year. At all subsequent Annual Meetings and Elections of Directors, Directors shall be elected for a term of two (2) years. At the 2010 Annual Meeting and Election of Directors, if there is no election because the number of candidates is equal to or less than the number of vacancies available, the Directors elected for an initial term of two (2) years shall be chosen by the Board of Directors as determined in their sole discretion.

Any director of the Board of Administration may be recalled and removed from office with or without cause by a vote or agreement in writing of the voting interests. A special meeting of the unit owners to recall a director or directors of the Board of Administration may be called by ten (10%) percent of the voting interests giving notice of the meeting as required for a meeting of unit owners, and the notice shall state the purpose of the meeting.

Item 2: Article 7 of the Articles of Incorporation of Somerset Bay Condominium Association, Inc. ("Articles"), shall be amended follows:

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the Board of Administration. The number of members of the Board of Administration of the corporation shall be a minimum of three (3) with the exact number determined ~~by a vote of the members~~ by the Bylaws. The members of the Board of Administration shall be elected as provided by the By-Laws of the corporation. The Board of Administration shall be members of the corporation or shall be authorized representatives, officers or employees of a corporate member of this corporation. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the first election of directors will be held in accordance with Article VI of the Declaration of Condominium of SOMERSET BAY, A CONDOMINIUM. Any vacancies in the Board of Administration occurring before the first election will be filled by the remaining directors, unless the vacancy occurs when both the Developer and unit owners other than the Developer are entitled to representation in which event the vacancy shall be filled by an election as provided in rule 61B-23.0021 F.A.C. The first election of director shall be held sixty (60) days from the date of recording of the Declaration of Condominium; thereafter, elections of directors shall be held once a year at the annual membership meeting.
